EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Up with Community is registered under the non-government organizations act, number 24 of 2002 as amended in 2005. The area the organization is operating in Tanzania mainland. Registration name 8521. The organization's main projects are in women, education, health, agriculture, environment, and volunteer training and water projects. By the support of KTCT early this March-2022 we have finished drilling a hand pump water borehole in Kazamwendo primary school in Buhigwe District, in Kigoma village. Kazamwendo Primary school is a primary school found in Buhigwe District in Kigoma region in Tanzania. They are 396 boys and 431 girls' students with total of 827 students in school.



The photo shows how the students came to school with water for the basic need in this primary school. Lack of clean and safe drinking water and inadequate sanitation has led to increased waterborne diseases with the school and

surrounding community during the rainy seasons, when people draw water from local shallow wells. Women teachers and girl students are the most vulnerable and are worst affected.

THE PROJECT

By the support of KTCT, UCO Tanzania has received grant in March 2022 which will help to get two local hand pump boreholes in Mlangilizi and Kazamwendo primary schools to service almost 1600 students to get safe water. Mboni group has drilled a local hand pump borehole in Kazamwendo after successful survey which was done in 7-4-2022 and now the project is done in Kazamwendo.

CHALLENGES

During implementation of this project we have overcome many challenges especially the rainfall and surveyed water area is a far a bit from toilet so water tank and the stand block is needed.
